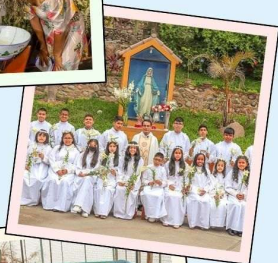
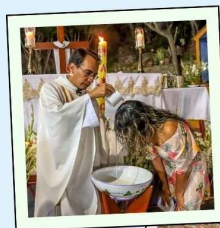

4. Select your parish by entering the parish zip code, (enter *45202* for St. Francis Xavier Church) then click "Sign Up"
5. You will then be taken to the main Formed site and should be automatically signed in and be able to access all the content

OFFICE NOTES

Supporting Bellarmine Chapel:

Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) from an IRA

For those who are 70 1/2 and older, you can make a charitable distribution directly from your qualified IRA plan. To qualify, the distribution must be made directly from your IRA to St. Robert Bellarmine Chapel. When done correctly, the amount distributed will not be included in your adjusted gross income. This offers several tax benefits, such as a reduction in taxable income even if you don't itemize, and possibly reducing the tax on your Social Security benefits. If you must take required minimum distributions (RMD), your charitable contribution can also satisfy all or part of the amount of your RMD. For more information about making a qualified charitable distribution to Bellarmine Chapel, please contact your IRA custodian or a tax professional.
